

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract And Any Amendments To The Contract With The New York State Department Of Health For The Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program – Public Health

The Health Services Committee (Chairman R.S. Parete and Legislators Briggs, Stoeckeler, Terpening, Petit, Roberti and Ronk) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a five year contract (Contract No. C023363) and any amendments to the contract, with funding in the amount of \$192,749.00 for the initial period of August 10, 2008 through August 9, 2009, with the New York State Department of Health for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County Public Health administers the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program as part of the Public Health Preparedness/Response for Bioterrorism which promotes emergency preparedness, including responsiveness to natural disasters and chemical, biological, nuclear and explosive (CBRNE) events, and

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a five year contract (Contract No. C023363) and any amendments to the contract, with funding in the amount of \$192,749.00 for the initial period of August 10, 2008 through August 9, 2009, with the New York State Department of Health for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, County participation will be reviewed by the Ways and Means Committee,
