

**Authorizing And Directing Charges Against Various Towns And The City Of Kingston For Home Relief Costs**

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Cahill, Dart, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Subdivision 6 (a) of Section 65 of Social Services Law requires the Commissioner of Social Services to provide Home Relief for local charges residing or found in a town of the County when the town public welfare officer is absent or the town public welfare officer has decided not to grant Home Relief as recommended, and

WHEREAS, Subdivision 6 (b) of Section 65 of Social Services Law further provides that expenditures made pursuant to this Section, subject to State reimbursement, shall be a charge on, and shall be reimbursed to the County by the Towns and the City of Kingston.

RESOLVED, that the following amounts be levied and assessed upon the taxable real property of the towns in the amounts indicated and when collected, be made payable to the Ulster County Treasurer as follows:
