

Requesting Transfer Of Funds For Estimated 207-C Compensation Pay Through Year End 2006 – Amending The 2006 Ulster County Budget – Sheriff’s Office

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Distel, Gregorius, R.A. Parete, Zimet, Aiello and Every) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff has estimated that an additional \$40,000.00 will be required to pay for 207-C Compensation Pay to year end 2006, and

WHEREAS, the number of 207-C claims has risen dramatically due to the Courts making it easier for Deputies to collect 207-C Workers Compensation, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff requests that \$40,000.00 be transferred from Contingency to 207-C Compensation Pay line, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
