

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into An Agreement With New York State Division Of Probation And Correctional Alternatives For Ulster County Alternatives To Incarceration Programs – 2006 – 2010 Contract – Alternative Sentencing**

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Distel, Gregorius, R.A. Parete, Zimet, Aiello and Every) offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 68 dated March 8, 2006, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature was authorized to enter into an agreement with New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for Ulster County Alternatives to Incarceration Programs (C550400), and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State Comptroller has recommended that State agencies begin using contracts written for a five (5) year term rather than a multi-year contract which will expedite internal processing of future annual contractual amendments, and

WHEREAS, the Coordinator of Alternative Sentencing has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to sign contract C550600 with New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for Ulster County's four (4) Alternatives to Incarceration Programs: Alternative Sentencing; Probation Pretrial; Community Corrections; and Defender Based Advocate (Public Defender) for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign agreements with New York State for Ulster County's four (4) Alternatives to Incarceration Programs: Alternative Sentencing; Probation Pretrial; Community Corrections; and Defender Based Advocate (Public Defender) for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2010, with funding as presently approved for the period ending December 31, 2006, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
