

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into Agreement With The Village Of New Paltz, Village Of Saugerties And Village Of Ellenville, Relating To The Enforcement Of Real Property Tax Liens Under Article 11 Foreclosure And Sections 1102, 1150, And 1110 Of The New York State Real Property Tax Law

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Bartels, Berardi, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has recommended an agreement between the County and the Villages within the County to provide for the division of the proceeds of sale of properties within the villages acquired for delinquent taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Paltz has no properties which will be sold for delinquent taxes at the 2007 Public Auction, therefore no agreement shall be entered into, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the respective legislative bodies of the Village of Saugerties and Village of Ellenville, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
