

**Confirmation Of Appointment Of Alvin Goren - Member Of The Ulster County Youth Board**

Referred to: The Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee (Chairman Harris and Legislators Lopez, Wawro, Donaldson and Gregorius)

Legislator Wayne Harris, Chairman of the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XLI Youth Bureau, Section C-123(A), of the Ulster County Charter and Section A41-3(A) of the Administrative Code, Youth Board: *“Membership; appointment; term. There shall be a Youth Board that shall consist of 15 members, at least two of whom shall be youth (between the ages of 16 and 21), who shall be appointed by the County Executive for a term of three years, subject to confirmation by the County Legislature. The Board shall encourage diverse representation indicative of the entire community. Membership shall reflect a balance between government and non-government representatives who are directly concerned with the well-being of youth and to represent the community to which it serves. All members of the Youth Board shall be residents of Ulster County. No member of the Youth Board shall hold any other County or state office. Members shall elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman for a term of one year. Board members shall be known as "Commissioners of the Youth Bureau of the County of Ulster" and shall receive no compensation for their services or activities except for actual and necessary expenses in the performance of duties as appropriated. The Sheriff of Ulster County, the Commissioner of Health or Public Health Director, the Family Court Judges, the County Attorney or his or her representative, the Commissioner of Social Services, and two members of the County Legislature designated by the Chairman of the County Legislature shall be ex officio members of the Youth Board,”* and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has appointed Alvin Goren, as a member to the Youth Board for the term beginning March 1, 2012 and ending on February 28, 2015, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II Legislative Branch, Section C-15 and Section A2-10, of the Administrative Code, Confirmation of appointments: *“A proposed appointment or proposed appointments to County office by the County Executive that require confirmation by the County Legislature under provisions of the Charter shall be presented by the County Executive to the Clerk of the Legislature in writing in sufficient time to allow the Clerk to inform the full Legislature of the proposed appointment or appointments at least two weeks prior to the Legislature's next scheduled meeting. If the Legislature fails to confirm or reject the proposed appointment or appointments by majority vote of all its elected*

*members by the next regular meeting occurring more than 15 days after the filing of the appointment with the Clerk, the appointment or appointments shall be deemed confirmed. When an appointment is rejected by the Legislature, the appointment of the same individual for the same position may not be resubmitted by the County Executive during his or her term of office,"* now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby confirms and/or rejects the appointment of Alvin Goren, as a member of the Ulster County Youth Bureau; confirmation is indicated by the majority of "AYES" votes or rejection of the appointment is indicated by the majority of "NOES" votes,

and moves its adoption.
