

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With New York State Division Of Criminal Justice Services – District Attorney’s Recruitment And Retention Program – District Attorney

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Briggs, R.A. Parete, Zimet, Aiello, Hansut and Ronk) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County District Attorney has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement, being said contract (T078668) in the amount of \$24,218.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program for the purpose of improving the recruitment and retention of qualified and experienced prosecutors through salary enhancement, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program, Project No. LG07-1552-D00 is Federal Pass-Thru State funded and will be administered for the period, starting April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, being said contract (T078668) in the amount of \$24,218.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program for the period of April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be reconsidered for future funding,

and moves its adoption.
