WHEREAS, participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) administered by the Governor's Office of Small Cities (GOSC) requires the holding of two public hearings consistent with a Community's Public Participation Plan, prior to the submittal of a grant application as well as an annual hearing to discuss past program performance, and

WHEREAS, the County desires to hold the necessary hearings to seek comment on the direction of its CDBG Program as well as Past Program Performance, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development/Education, Tourism and Cultural Affairs Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that a combined Public Hearing on the direction of the County's CDBG and past program performance will be held on Thursday, February 10, 2005 at 7:00 PM in the Legislative Chambers, 6th Floor, Ulster County Office Building, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, New York, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature is directed to cause a legal notice of said Public Hearing to be published according to Law and the County's CDBG Public Participation Plan, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature is directed to cause posting of such notice of hearing on County Buildings' bulletin boards, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature is directed to provide a copy of the hearing notice to all elected officials of municipalities within Ulster County, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that as necessary, the Chairman is authorized to call a second public hearing and direct notice of same, to meet program requirements consistent with the County's Public Participation Plan,
