

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement For The Maintenance Of Facilities For The Ulster Performing Arts Center For The 2012 Appropriation – Legislature

Referred to: The Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee (Chairman Harris and Legislators Lopez, Wawro, Donaldson and Gregorius) and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Provenzano and Rodriguez)

Legislator Wayne Harris, Chairman of the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee and Legislator Richard Gerentine, Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee offer the following:

WHEREAS, performing arts are an important component of our cultural heritage, and the many performances arranged by the Ulster Performing Arts Center attract the Hudson Valley County residents as well as travelers to see a broad range of entertainment for the community, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Law Section 224 (13), the Ulster County Legislature appropriated to the Ulster Performing Arts Center the sum of \$18,750.00 in the 2012 Ulster County Budget for the maintenance of facilities, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Law Section 224 (13), in order to receive such funds, the Ulster Performing Arts Center must submit to the Ulster County Legislature a verified accounting of disbursements to be undertaken, and to the Commissioner of Finance, a Memorandum of Receipt signed by the principal officer, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster Performing Arts Center will receive payment in the amount of \$18,750.00, in accordance with the terms specified in an agreement with the County of Ulster and the Ulster Performing Arts Center and will return any unexpended funds as of December 31, 2012, along with a certified accounting of expenditures to the Commissioner of Finance, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that as part of the agreement, the Comptroller and/or any and all officers of the County of Ulster, their agents and representatives, shall be allowed full access upon reasonable notice and at reasonable times to the books, papers, records and premises of the Ulster Performing Arts Center, during the period that this resolution is in effect for the purpose of ascertaining the manner in which the above sum of money is being used or applied, and, be it further

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RESOLVED, that the above organization agrees to comply with all applicable Federal, State and local regulations including, in particular, any forbidding discrimination by such organization, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that as part of the agreement, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement in the amount of \$18,750.00, for the maintenance of facilities for the Ulster Performing Arts Center, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and move its adoption.
