WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 355 dated November 14, 2007, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature was authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance to accept funds in the amount of \$70,000.00, for the Community Solutions for Transportation (CSTVIII) Program for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, and

WHEREAS, there is no increased County contribution associated with this transaction, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
