WHEREAS, New York State is the recipient of United States Department of Education funding for Special Education Grants for infants and families (CFDA 84.181) which is administered as a pass through to local agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services has requested that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Health for the Early Intervention Program (NYS Contract No. C-027515) in the amount of \$108,257.00 for the term October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health for the Early Intervention Program (NYS Contract No. C-027515) in the amount of \$108,257.00 for the term of October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,

and moves its adoption.
