WHEREAS, Ulster County has received funds from the New York State Department of Transportation for CHIPS funding for Ulster County Highway Capital Improvements, for the State Fiscal Year 2006 – 2007, and

WHEREAS, there remains unexpended funds in the amount of \$98,344.73 for the Ulster County Highways and Bridges for the year 2007 Capital Expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Highways and Bridges has requested that the 2007 County Road Fund Budget be amended to provide these funds in order to provide the additional resources for the Highway Construction Program, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
