Jeff retired from FDNY in 2006 due to massive injuries sustained while operating at a deadly fire in the Bronx that took the lives of LT Curt Meyran and FF John Bellew. The fire also took the life of Joey DiBernardo on November 22, 2011. He died as a result of the injuries he sustained on Black Sunday. Jeff will lecture on firefighter safety and the need for personal safety ropes for all firefighters across the country.

Come join us and hear Jeff talk about the lessons learned from what has come to be known in the fire service as “Black Sunday.” A day where two veteran FDNY firefighters died in the Bronx on Sunday January 23, 2005, a day called one of the saddest in fire department history. Two firefighters were killed and four others were badly hurt when they were forced to jump from a fourth floor window of a burning building in the Bronx. Later, a third firefighter died after tackling a basement blaze in Brooklyn.
