Committee Discussion:

Legislators Noonon and Hansut have been fielding phone calls and emails on Timothy's Law – a state mental health law for substance abuse and mental health clients – established by the state in 2006 for a 3 year period and is due to expire. It helps families and employers by subsidizing aid through insurance. Governor Paterson supports this legislation - signed off on it this morning. Legislator Noonan suggests a memorializing resolution of support to prepare for June's meeting – however possibly may be time sensitive. Legislator Hansut will email committee members information he has on Timothy's Law. Timothy's Law can also be viewed on line. Chairman Gregorius asked Legislator Terpening to discuss at the next Health Committee Meeting and then bring this committee up to speed.
