- City of Kingston Planning Board Received Notice of Completion of Final EIS – Hudson Landing
- Letter and Petition to Town of New Paltz on behalf of Woodland Pond to lower the speed limit on North Putt Corners Road
- Village of Saugerties – SEQRA Notice and Intent to serve as Lead Agency – Partition Street Project, LLC for Redevelopment of the former Cantine Mill Property – situate on 7.7 acres - 500 seat catering hall, 150 seat restaurant, 30 room hotel with parking, associated municipal infrastructure and other improvements in the planned Waterfront (PW) Zoning Dist and Residential 3 Acre Zoning Dist.
- Town of Woodstock Planning Board – Notice of Completion of Draft EIS & Notice of SEQR/TWEQR Public Hearing – Woodstock Commons (RUPCO) – Affordable Housing Community consisting of up to 12 residential structures, a multi-use community center, maintenance building, stormwater control facilities and a road system. Projected number of occupants is 140. Public hearing Feb 5, 2009, comments accepted until Feb 18, 2009.
- Village of New Paltz Planning Board – Received Supplemental Draft EIS for Stonleigh Woods at New Paltz – applicant has requested Site Plan, Subdivision & Special Use Permit approvals for development of a scaled down version of original project. Plan now proposed to include a total of 116 single family dwelling units in 2 housing styles; as well as a 24 unit senior apartment building on 63.3 acres. Comments on SDEIS will be accepted until March 27th. A public hearing will be held at 7:00 PM March 5th at Deyo Hall, New Paltz.
