Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Proposed Amendment

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) is proposing an amendment to the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP): the five-year capital program that assigns federal funds to transportation projects located in Ulster County. The Council periodically updates the TIP to add new projects, remove existing projects, or change a project's cost, schedule, or scope. Significant changes are classified as an addition or deletion of larger infrastructure projects or otherwise as any amendment causing changes that will materially affect travel for the public. Such amendments require a public comment period of 15 calendar days prior to action.
