### **Proposed Amendments** **Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2018-2021** **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** **and** **UCTC SFY 2018/19 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has initiated a 15 day public comment period on proposed amendments to its Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and SFY 2018/19 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

#### Unified Planning Work Program

The UPWP is UCTC's transportation planning work program that supports the goals, objectives and recommendations of the UCTC's Year 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan. The UPWP includes descriptions of planning tasks and resulting products, and identifies which organization will perform each task, a schedule for completing tasks, the cost of the work, and sources of funds. The Council periodically updates the UPWP to adjust or change a project's cost or scope. Amendments require a public comment period of 15 calendar days prior to action.

- Resolution 2018-07: Amendment to the UCTC State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2018/19 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) to reprogram the Route 9W Corridor Management Study

#### Transportation Improvement Program

The TIP is a five-year capital program that assigns federal funds to transportation projects located in Ulster County. The following are the proposed amendments to the TIP:
