State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2017 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Proposed Amendment

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) is proposing an amendment to the State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2017 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP): the statement of work, identifying the federally funded transportation planning activities in Ulster County. The UPWP includes descriptions of planning tasks and resulting products, and identifies which organization will perform each task, a schedule for completing tasks, the cost of the work, and sources of funds. The Council periodically updates the UPWP to adjust or change a project's cost or scope. Significant changes include, but are not limited to, a change exceeding 25 percent of the budgeted amount for a project. Such amendments require a public comment period of 15 calendar days prior to action.
