ULSTER COUNTY PLANNING BOARD Minutes – September 7, 2016

The Ulster County Planning Board Meeting **7:30 p.m.** – Surrogate Courtroom, 3rd Floor County Office Building

The Executive Committee Met at 6:30PM

Chairman Baden called the meeting to order and asked Mr. Leibowitz to read the roll call.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The August minutes were approved. Motion by Mr. Calimano, seconded by Mr. Konior. All were in favor.

3. FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Doyle stated we are well into the budget season at the County level. The department's proposed budget for next year is about the same as 2016, with a recommended upgrade for the Transportation Planner to Sr. Transportation Planner. We have encumbered approximately \$200,000 for studies that are about to begin. At the end of the year we will encumber additional money for ongoing studies and contracts. We have proposed to have federally required studies (contracts) funded through the Capital Program budget for next year.

Mr. Doyle explained that the board does not have responsibility for the budget; this item is for information only.

5. COMMUNITY REPORT

Mr. Watkins stated that Mr. Calimano, Mr. Brooks, Mr. Wilkin and Mr. Doyle came to Town of Shawangunk to speak to their Planning Board, as most of their current board members are new. He said it was very informative and he felt it helped the entire board. Mr. Watkins thanked Mr. Doyle for doing a good job and the others who attended for their support. Mr. Watkins stated that the Wallkill Centers property is coming back. Another person purchased the project who is proposing Sr housing and other nice buildings. Mr. Watkins explained that this was originally proposed as a commercial application, but decided it should be residential to support local businesses. Mr. Watkins added that Town of Shawangunk is unique in that the town center is not built out and this is a good opportunity for the town.

Mr. Baden extended the invitation to have our board come speak to their local board about the process or any other topic.

Mr. Andreassen attended the FEMA seminar on Stormwater and Flood Plain Management by DEC in Goshen.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

Mr. Doyle made note of Town of New Paltz Planning Board – Resolution & Record of Decision – SEQRA Negative Declaration – River to Ridge Trail Site Plan

7. OLD BUSINESS

a. Planning Seminar – Monday, September 26th from 7:00-9:30PM at SUNY Ulster "Build a Better Record – Good Practices for Documenting Local Board Decisions"

Chairman Baden made note of the above. He added that this is a training he had given to the Planning Federation two years ago. Ms. Lanzetta asked if there would be any other UC sponsored trainings before the end of the year. She said there were farmers on her board that have an issue with the timing of this seminar. Mr. Baden stated that Town of Olive asked him for training at their location. Mr. Calimano stated Town of New Paltz has their meeting that night. Mr. Baden offered to visit Boards if they couldn't make this seminar.

8. SPECIAL TOPICS DISCUSSION

Mr. Doyle stated that we anticipate having design approval for the trail in the Town of Lloyd from South Road to Old New Paltz Road by the end of this month. He added that Deputy Director Chris White will be speaking at the Paltz Club Thursday night with a presentation of all the trails systems going on.

Mr. Doyle called attention to the grant notices, where the State Dept of Transportation has released TAP funding (Transportation Alternatives Program), which run through UCTC, for projects in the region. He noted that Ulster County got \$1.8 million for trails work last time this came through. Funding can also be used for sidewalks, cross walks, etc. Mr. Doyle noted that applications are due Oct 21st.

9. NEW BUSINESS

a. Membership Update

Mr. Baden introduced Mr. Gagliardi, proposed member for City of Kingston. Mr. Baden also wanted to remind members that there are many terms expiring at the end of the year: Gardiner, Town of New Paltz, Hurley, Rosendale and Shawangunk. The alternate for Wawarsing was not reappointed. Also one member for City of Kingston whose term ran out in 2012 has been a no show with no replacement. Mr. Baden stated that our board members may serve after their term expires until they resign or are replaced. Chairman Baden stated he may be requesting this person's resignation. He encouraged member's whose terms will be expiring to contact their local board to begin reappointment procedure.
