Technical Advisory Committee Meeting June 1, 2017, 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM

### 1. Status of Existing Studies and Data Requests

- Crash Data: BFJ-SGB to talk individually with police departments from both Towns to obtain pedestrian and bicycle crash reports from last 10 years.
- Gas Pipeline: Central Hudson to send scanned drawings of pipeline easement to UCTC.
- Zoning, sewer, and water district maps: BFJ to contact the following people to obtain up-to-date information:

## 2. Task Updates

- Public Outreach
  - Intercept Survey: SGB with assistance from UCTC conducted a full day of intercept surveys on May 4th. The team talked with over 90 people. A summary of findings and insights is contained within the draft workshop presentation attached to the meeting notes.
  - Focus Groups:
    - The project team has pivoted from its original plan of administering three focus groups on June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>.
    - The first focus group with business owners will take place on June 1st at 4pm.
    - The second focus group will be held once concepts have been developed. Tentative dates: October 6<sup>th</sup> or 13<sup>th</sup>.
    - In lieu of a third focus group, BFJ-SGV will conduct individual meetings/calls with emergency service personnel. The first of these meetings was conducted with Chief Gerald Cocozza on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
