## Ulster County Transportation Council Extends the Comment Period for the Building a Better Broadway Project to Friday September 4, 2015

At the request of Shayne Gallo, Mayor of the City of Kingston, the Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has extended the comment period for the Building a Better Broadway Project to Friday September 4, 2015.

The Building a Better Broadway Project is funded by the UCTC to assist the City of Kingston's efforts to improve the Broadway Corridor so that it can be safer and more efficient for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians, all while addressing the concerns of residents and business owners. The City has approximately 4.5 million dollars in federal and state funding to begin this work. Before any construction the City will complete additional detailed design for the work to be done in the corridor.
