**Building a Better
Broadway**

The City of Kingston anticipates over \$6 million in federal and state transportation investments along the Broadway corridor in the next 3-5 years. The Ulster County Transportation Council is helping Kingston explore how the street can function better for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians, all while keeping in mind the concerns of local residents and business owners.

Attend the public meeting on **Thursday August 6th** at UPAC to learn how the work is progressing. Attendees will be presented the City's draft feasible alternative road design which will serve as the basis for development of the final design. Final designs will continue to be refined by the City and its consultants through the fall. Your input is important.
