Finding Rosendale Circulation and Wayfinding Plan
Community Planning and Design Workshops

County Executive Michael P. Hein, Chairman of the Ulster County Transportation Council and the Town of Rosendale invite local residents and business owners to participate in the development of the "Finding Rosendale" Plan: a circulation and wayfinding plan for the Town of Rosendale focused on NYS Route 213 (Main Street), the Walkkill Valley Rail Trail, and municipal parking and recreation areas nearby.

The initial Public Information Meeting will be held on **Thursday, November 20th from 7:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. at the Rosendale Recreation Center**. The meeting will introduce the project to the community, provide information about existing wayfinding resources and past studies, and allow the public to provide input on the direction of the Finding Rosendale Plan. No technical expertise is required of public participants. Mapping of the project area will be provided in multiple forms for the public to view and to utilize to share their ideas and comments.
