### **SFY 2016 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) is inviting public review and comment on the draft SFY 2016 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for the Ulster County Metropolitan Planning Area.

UCTC is responsible for the development of an annual UPWP. The UPWP sets priorities for transportation-related planning activities of UCTC and includes the funding levels for projects for the upcoming year. The UPWP must support the goals, objectives and recommendations of UCTC's Year 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan and be compliant with the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, the latest federal surface transportation act signed into law on December 4, 2015.
