2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The April minutes were approved. Motion by Mr. Wilkin, seconded by Mr. McCarthy. All were in favor.

Mr. Doyle stated we have been receiving email notifications for webinars and we'll try to share them as they come up. He added that if anyone attends a webinar they should send us an email to record the training credit.

Ms. Mance said even though she represents Hurley on the County Planning Board, she wanted to say thanks for the recommendations for Town of Esopus to replace Alan Sorenson, the Town Planner.

Mr. Wilkin stated that Executive Order 202.14 expires May 7th and asked if anyone heard any updates. He added that the order was signed April 7th and extends the inperson requirement of open meeting law through May 7th. Mr. Doyle stated we would look into it. Mr. McLaughlin later confirmed that it was extended to June 6th.

6. PLANNING DEPARTMENT REPORTS

a. Financial Report

Mr. Doyle informed the Board that the County has instituted a hiring freeze and a memo was sent asking departments to cut 10% of this year's budget. Mr. Doyle noted that our cuts came from Professional Services, conference attendance and mileage accounts, which amounted to approximately \$170,000. Mr. Baden stated that he got the email on Phase 2 of the Brownfield's study and asked if there was a new due date. Mr. Leibowitz stated the State delayed the date of release and added that it hasn't been moved on it yet. Mr. Doyle explained to the Board that we did a

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pre-nomination study that looked at 5 areas of county through a Consolidated Funding Applications (CFA) opportunity grant. We were told funding would be released 4/29, so we are waiting to see what is going on. Mr. Baden said the money is collected out of user fees, so hopefully it won't be defunded.

Mr. Doyle informed the Board that the passage of the Budget bill included a streamlined review process for solar energy siting. We are looking at this and will draft a Planner's Memo on it. Mr. Doyle stated there was significant pushback from communities originally because it pertained to facilities as small as 10 megawatts and is now limited to 25 MW and can opt-in at 20 MW. Existing facilities can also opt in.

Mr. Doyle stated he wanted to discuss social distancing at the trails. He noted that a number of signs have been erected on the Ashokan Rail Trail, the Sheriff's Dept has also been there and the volunteers are still there. Mr. Boggess stated he was avoiding the trails due to the number of people.

Ms. Winer stated that the Mayor of Ellenville has asked about finding a template for signs to social distance and wear masks. Mr. Doyle said the templates we used are from Wallkill Valley Land Trust and offered to share them.
