AMENDMENT TO THE ULSTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) TO DELETE PROJECT NO LONGER NEEDED – PIN 882341: ROUTE 32, SUNY NEW PALTZ BUS STOP RELOCATION AND IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Kingston Urbanized Area and a portion of the Poughkeepsie-Newburgh Orange County Urbanized area; and,

WHEREAS, Federal rules and regulations require that a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), including a Triennial Element, be developed and adopted by the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization;

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Transportation Council has been officially designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for Ulster County and is authorized to amend the Transportation Improvement Program as needed to add or delete projects; modify costs, schedules and funding for federally funded projects; and

WHEREAS, the amendment as detailed in Attachment 1 has been requested by the Responsible Agency or UCTC staff in an effort to eliminate PIN 882341 from the UCTC TIP; and

WHEREAS, the state and federal funds associated with PIN 882341 will be programmed as additional funds to the two existing NYSDOT Park and Ride projects in Ulster County – PINs 882342: Kingston Park and Ride Lot Expansion and PIN 882343: Saugerties Park and Ride Development or Ulster County as needed; and

WHEREAS, the UCTC, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) and public transit providers, has reviewed and documented compliance of its planning process with adopted *UCTC Operating Procedures*, UCTC public notice procedures, and all existing federal rules and regulations, including *The Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act* (MAP-21) requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Transportation Council amends its Transportation Improvement Program to remove projects as shown in Attachment 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Ulster County Transportation Council authorizes the Secretary to transmit the TIP Amendment to the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for STIP approval.
