Tom Konrad, Chair, Marbletown Environmental Conservation Commission (ECC)

Marbletown is widely recognized as a leader in the transition to 100% Renewables. The Marbletown ECC developed a strategy for obtaining 100% of the community's energy from renewable sources.

Marbletown achieved Bronze Status in New York's Climate Smart Communities Program, completed 8 of the 10 NYSERDA High Impact Action Items, and is the first Ulster County town to implement Community Choice Aggregation (CCA).

The Marbletown ECC was a driving force behind Ulster County's adoption of the "Ban the [plastic] Bag" legislation and the "Skip the Straw" local law that makes plastic straws a request only commodity in county restaurants.
