### About Your Project

#### Title of Project:

Ellenville CaravanKids and Into the Light: A Winter Holiday Performance (Ellenville High School)

### Description of the Project:

The Vanaver Caravan provides *Ellenville CaravanKids Workshops*, with Vanaver Caravan Teaching Artist, Juliet ten Broeke, at Ellenville Public Library & Museum (EPL&M) on eight Thursdays, 4:00-5:30PM, October 5 — December 7, 2017. A performance of *Into the Light* by The Vanaver Caravan and Arm of the Sea Theater with *CaravanKids* will take place on Saturday, December 9, 2017, 3:00PM in the Ellenville High School Auditorium (Snow date, Sunday, December 10, 2017, 3:00PM). The performance is free and open to the public.

Into the Light will brighten the winter holiday season in Ellenville again for the fourth year, on December 9, 2017, when Ellenville Public Library & Museum sponsors this family-friendly performance by The Vanaver Caravan and Arm of the Sea Theater, with special guests. For the past four years, this multicultural pageant has engaged audiences from Ellenville and the surrounding area with live music, puppetry, and dances from around the world. Performers include professional Vanaver Caravan dancers and musicians, as well as CaravanKids and the recently formed Ellenville CaravanKids.

In the past, EPL&M received a grant from Arts Mid-Hudson to host dance and music workshops taught by The Vanaver Caravan instructors. "We wanted to facilitate local kids being able to study and train with The Vanaver Caravan in Southern Ulster County," said Asha Golliher, former Outreach Librarian at EPL&M, which serves Ellenville as well as Rochester and Wawarsing. "Performing with The Vanaver Caravan and Arm of the Sea in *Into the Light* is a wonderful opportunity. Our joint vision is about using the program to build community. The show is inspiring for everyone."

Into the Light tells a story of Lucia's world travels to learn the ways that light is kept glowing through the darkest part of the year, in communities around the globe. Into the Light touches on a variety of winter holiday traditions including Chanukah, Christmas, Kwanzaa, Diwali, Sankta Lucia (Sweden), Winter Solstice, and Yule. Livia Vanaver notes that, "This important ritual of bringing light into the darkest time of year is a metaphor reminding us that...joining with community, we can overcome darkness."

### How does this project advance economic development in Ellenville/Wawarsing?

There is a beneficial economic impact of the EPL&M partnering with The Vanaver Caravan to create *Ellenville CaravanKids*. The economic benefits to Ellenville includes both events; the dance classes at the library and the performance at the Ellenville High School, as well as the library's use of local services for brochure printing and local media for print ads, and the purchase of snack foods at local stores for the children taking the *Ellenville CaravanKids* dance workshops (ranging, variously, from seven to eighteen

children, from one year to the next). Following the rehearsal and performance of *Into the Light*, The Vanaver Caravan Company members, their families, friends, and local audiences go to local restaurants for dinner. It is worth noting that not only do audiences go to local restaurants and shops before and after the performance, but the artists (The Vanaver Caravan, musicians, Arm-of-the-Sea Theater, special guests, Barely Lace, musicians, and dancers) gather at a local restaurant for a post-performance dinner and celebration, every year. Approximately 25 performers, and their families, dine in Ellenville following the annual performance, in addition to another 25-30 *CaravanKids* dancers and their families. This has a beneficial direct economic impact in the village, bringing some visitors previously unfamiliar with Ellenville, and leading to future visits and commerce.

Many Ellenville residents do not have the opportunity, due to issues such as income and accessibility, to enjoy and participate in live artistic and cultural events. The world dance classes for the *Ellenville CaravanKids* prepare them to participate in *Into the Light*, providing a fun, educational, family-friendly program designed to draw a diverse, multi-generational audience. These events draw people from the surrounding area to Ellenville, strengthening regional relationships and the perception of the town as a viable part of Ulster County's artistic community.
