WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office is required to upgrade the Live Scan Equipment and Software due to the current system is no longer supported; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office has been awarded a NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services Grant to purchase “Live Scan Equipment” in order to upgrade the current Live Scan System; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2020-2025 Capital Improvement Program includes a project “Live Scan” in the amount of \$175,000.00 for such project; and

WHEREAS, the Live Scan Equipment purchased will be reimbursed by NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services up to \$70,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County share will be \$55,000.00; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Capital Project 571 - Live Scan Upgrade is hereby established in the amount of \$175,000.00 as follows:
