REQUIREMENTS OF THE ULSTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AS
TERMS OF ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT FOR COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION
AND DISPOSAL OF OFFENSIVE MATERIALS IN ULSTER COUNTY

1. Identification – The vehicles used must bear business name and Ulster County Permit Number, in a prominent place, on the sides and rear of the vehicle, using numerals at least four inches high of a color to contrast with the background to insure and enhance their visibility at a distance.
2. Vehicles and containers used for the collection, storage and transportation of offensive materials must be self contained to prevent any spillage of offensive materials into the environment.
3. Vehicles and containers used for the collection, storage, and transportation of offensive materials must be self contained and properly covered to prevent odor, insect and rodent nuisances.
4. Proper equipment must be provided on the vehicle to facilitate clean-up, if a spill of offensive materials occurs, during the course of the collection.
5. Vehicles and containers must be cleaned on a regular basis to prevent odor, insect and rodent nuisances.
6. Disposal of offensive materials is only allowed at New York State Department of Environmental Conservation permitted facilities.
7. The telephone number of a person who can be contacted regarding operational problems must appear on the application form. Note if different than that of permittee.
8. All collection vehicles must be registered. Adding or substituting vehicles to those listed on your application must be reported immediately to the Ulster County Department of Health.
