
Dear Suzanne:

Several years ago, the village of Ellenville applied for a Hudson River Valley Greenway (Greenway) grant of \$10,000 to do a "Downtown Revitalization Plan for Center Street and Market Street in support of their efforts to leverage economic growth along nearby Canal Street." The Greenway recommended a grant of \$7,500 out of the requested \$10,000 which would have to be matched by the Village. Assuming the Greenway had approved the original ask of \$10,000, the total project cost would have been \$20,000.

Recently, in order to conduct a master plan for Berme Park, the Village agreed to forego their grant request from the Greenway for the Downtown Revitalization Plan (the \$7,500 - it had not been drawn down), having placed a higher priority upon the park project with the recent creation of the joint Town/Village parks commission.

Hudson Valley Pattern for Progress, as part of their work in support of the Ellenville Million, proposes to do the original scope of work, approved by the Greenway for the Downtown Revitalization Plan for \$12,000.
