PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

Chairman Kenneth Ronk granted Privilege of the Floor to former Ulster County Legislator Jack Hayes representing the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks Lodge 2568, New Paltz, NY and Diane Sutkowski from Prostate Cancer 101 (PCa 101), Kingston, NY discussed the importance of early detection, education and treatment of Prostate Cancer and discussed the outreach and support these partners provide to residents of Ulster County and their families.

Chairman Kenneth Ronk called upon Legislator Craig Lopez, Chairman of Public Health and Social Services Committee and joined by Legislator Chris Allen, Deputy Chair of Public Health and Social Services Committee who presented a Proclamation to BPOE 2568 declaring September as “Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.” and a Pride of Ulster County Award to PCa 101.

1. Frank Nazzaro, Kingston: Mr. Nazzaro asked for a moment of silence in honor of his friend Pat Byrne of Kingston, a co-worker at the First Baptist Church. Mr. Azzaro also played a Catskill Mountain railroad video produced by Ryan Lenox from his cell phone.
2. Bryan A. Blas: Mr. Blas read and provided his written comments for the record in support of the railroad, and allowing the train access to the Glennford Dyke area vs. the false narrative presented by the county and the press.

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3. Meg Carey: Ms. Carey read and provided her written comments for the record in support of the U&D corridor and disregard of Resolution No. 488, noting Stony Hollow Rt. 28A railroad crossing being paved over. Ms. Carey would like to see more public participation.
4. Nick Mercurio, Cottekill: Mr. Mercurio commended the county for paving Stony Hollow road, including the rails at the railroad crossing in the name of public safety. Mr. Mercurio pointed out extremely poor road conditions with bad sight lines.
