Award Categories

Eligibility Criteria

Nominees must:

- Reside (Individual Award) or operate (Organizational Award) in Ulster County, NY.
- Have demonstrated actions or initiatives that align with the principles of human rights, equity and inclusivity.
- Have made a measurable difference in the lives of individuals or the community as a whole.

Nominations must include:

1. The name and contact information of the nominee
2. A detailed description of their contributions to human rights in Ulster County.
3. Supporting materials, such as letters of recommendation, publicly recognized accomplishments, documented programs, policies, initiatives
