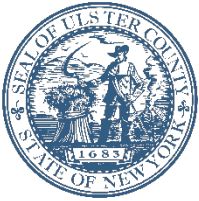

- Forest Park takes water from the Delaware River and filters it to provide high quality drinking water to thousands of customers in Bucks and Montgomery County. It is one of the largest water diversion projects in the East. As a part of the process the solids that are separated from the processed water are then delivered to local farmers as an organic soil substitute (the farmers are paid to receive this organic material).
