

A jail grows in Kingston

ironworkers arranged a shipment of structural steel. Elsewhere, a crane removed panels that had been used to build forms for concrete.

About 90 people are working at the site. Next week, when the masonry work starts in earnest, that number will exceed 100.

Work must be stringently scheduled because of the number of trades working simultaneously. To assure construction is completed within the projected 18 months, the various trades work in sequence around the semicircular building. For example, once a section of foundation is complete, ironworkers come in to install the structural steel in that section. They are followed by masons, who lay the concrete block that makes up the walls of the facility. Then come the roofers.

"All things considered, given the magnitude of the project and the number of trades working together, it's going quite well," said Brian Cunningham, the county's onsite jail project manager.

Sleight praised construction manager Bovis Lend Lease, which he said has done a great job coordinating work at the site.

Work is slightly behind schedule because of the harsh winter. Cunningham said the allowance for snow delays was based on a 10-year snowfall average, which proved inadequate this year.

"We lost a few weeks, maybe a month due to the weather," he said. "That aside, production is where it should be. There's places where you can try to recover some time and accelerate the schedule. The main goal is to get it, for the most part, pretty much weather-tight by November."

Cunningham also said the project is on budget.

Sleight said the underpinnings of the project are just as impressive as what is now visible at the site. "You have literally miles of underground conduit for cables and communications, water, heating ventilation and air-conditioning, sewer and sanitary and storm drains," he said. "All of that stuff has to be in and under all those slabs

KINGSTON - Nearly seven months after a groundbreaking ceremony at a vacant construction site on Albert Street, Ulster County's new Law Enforcement Center is starting to take shape.

Structural steel now rises from areas where foundation work is complete, giving a visual form to a structure that has, for years, existed only on paper. The foundation work is two-thirds complete, and towering steel beams are being installed, outlining the building's form.

"It's good to see the steel going up. It really looks like we're building a building," said county Buildings and Grounds Commissioner Harvey Sleight.

A recent visit to the site found it humming with activity. In one area, ironworkers arranged a shipment of structural steel. Elsewhere, a crane removed panels that had been used to build forms for concrete.



Over the next two weeks, a sample of the precast cell units, which are being manufactured in New Hampshire, will be delivered to the site. The full shipment of precast cells will arrive sometime in the early summer. Once they arrive, according to Cunningham, work will progress quickly, and all the cells should be fully installed by the end of August.

At 277,000 square feet, and with a \$71.8 million price tag, the Law Enforcement Center is the county's largest construction project to date. It will house a 134,253-square-foot jail with 402 cells - and up to 498 beds - as well as jail administration and support services and the Ulster County Sheriff's Office. The county's current jail, on Golden Hill Drive, was completed in 1973 and has 281 beds.

The Law Enforcement Center is due to be completed in September 2004.


