The New York State Certified First Responder –Original / Refresher Courses will be held at the Woodstock FD. Com 5, Rescue Building, 226 Tinker St, Woodstock, NY.

The Original course runs 5/13/25 to 07/01/25, 1900 to 22:30.

The Refresher challenge exam and challenge PSE is on 5/13/25. Start time 18:00.

Classes are held Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1900-2230 with 1 Saturday class. All classes are mandatory.

You must be 16 years old by July 31, 2025 to register for this course.

The final state practical examination is Saturday 06/28/25 at 0900.

The state written examination is now Computer Based Testing and upon successful completion of the course all completion documents will be forwarded to NYS DOH BEMSAT. The student will receive a confirmation E-Mail from the testing agency. You will then be required to schedule your exam date.

Full payment of course tuition of \$250.00 per person for Original students and \$ 120.00.00 for Refresher students is due at the beginning of the course. We will ***not*** be accepting State Funding in lieu of payment. To be eligible for NYS Tuition Reimbursement you should be a member of an Agency with a NYS BEMSAT Agency Code by the end of the course. NYS BEMSAT has updated the funding requirements. If you become an active member of an agency with a NYS BEMSAT Agency Code you and your agency can claim Tuition Reimbursement.

If you would like to request a payment plan for your tuition, please include that with your registration.

Upon successful completion of the course, students belonging to an Agency with a NYS BEMSAT Agency Code can claim reimbursement for the full \$250.00 Original or \$120.00 Refresher, from NYS BEMSAT. If the Agency does not have a NYS Vendor ID, Woodstock EMS Programs will work with you to apply for the reimbursement.

Students must be physically capable of performing all required skills included in the CFR Program as defined by the NYS DOH, BEMSAT, Functional Job Description of an CFR and be able to participate in all classroom activities in a normal classroom environment.
