- b. Public Education Subcommittee
  - i. Education and Outreach Proposal to UCTC Slack
    - 1. No written proposal has been completed at this time; Mr. Slack provided a verbal presentation of the general proposal to the UCTC Policy Committee at the 11/28 meeting; the Policy Committee was initially supportive of the approach.

Draft will be developed in early 2024; Ulster County Charter requires an annual report to be presented to the Legislature and County Executive on or before March 1 of each year
- c. NYS Safe Streets Coalition: Policy on 25MPH Speed Limits Rosemary Quinn
  - i. Policy paper was presented to the TSB; Ms. Quinn requested that members consider supporting the policy at the next meeting. No action.
- d. NYS Institute of Traffic Safety Management and Research Data Rosemary Quinn
  - i. Agenda item was tabled due to technical difficulties.
- e. 2024 School Bus Driver of the Year & Charlie Schaller Awards All
  - i. SBDotY award will be coordinated with Dutchess TSB later in 2024; the Charlie Schaller Award is open to any Ulster County first responder or citizen who has been outstanding in the field of traffic safety.

Mr. Slack mentioned that Rhonda Barangan indicated a need to resign her position at UCC as Traffic Safety Coordinator; her family will be moving to Connecticut.
