Ulster County may waive the requirements of Section 304-51, paragraph B of the Food Waste Prevention and Recovery Act if the County determines that compliance with the requirements of paragraph B would result in extraordinary financial hardship to the large food scraps generator or that other unique circumstances justify a waiver. Any waiver granted hereunder shall be for a maximum period of one year.

1. Request for Waiver

Pursuant to Chapter 304-51, Section F of the Ulster County Code, a Waiver from the Food Waste Prevention and Recovery Act regulations is hereby requested. A request for Waiver shall be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and may be granted in whole or in part, with or without conditions, for a maximum period of one year.
