1. Request for exemption.

Pursuant to <u>Chapter 304-56 of the Ulster County Code</u>, an exemption from the Food Waste Prevention and Recovery Act regulations a regulated large food scraps generator may request an exemption at any time indicating that the amount of food scraps that it generates is not sufficient to subject it to the requirements of the Law. Dispute of Status submissions shall be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and may be granted or revoked at the County's discretion.

____ A) For generators disputing their status based on the actual amount of food waste generated, a waste audit is required. 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_____B) For a dispute of food waste calculation assumptions: Submit an attestation that the assumptions used in the food waste calculations are incorrect (e.g. fewer employees than indicated). Backup documentation shall be provided to support the claim:

- Calculations using methodology provided by the NYS Pollution Prevention Institute Food Waste Estimator³, to include correct Category, Input Fields and Food Waste Generation Factor
- ____ C) For a dispute based on the definition of large food scraps generator.

Attach:

- A narrative describing how the business model, product/service, or supply chain arrangement of the entity ensures that no food scraps are generated during operations.
- Other information to justify the claim as needed.

For each case above, additional documentation may be required by the Department upon review of the submitted Dispute of Status application.
