| Ulster | New Paltz | New Paltz Schools are partnering with local government and local non-profits to provide breakfast and lunch to Free/Reduced students as well as others in the community who may be in need. With respect to distribution, we are finalizing ways of meeting our confidentiality obligations. We will use our middle school as a centralized distribution site as well as using a District bus for drop offs at selected locations. |
| Ulster | Onteora | Onteora CSD is currently working on setting up a meal delivery system right now. We hope to be fully functional by Wednesday. We are offering to all families who request them. My Food Services manager is sending in the application today hopefully. We are planning to have our transportation department deliver meals across the District. We may bundle multiple days meals in one delivery. |
| Ulster | Rondout Valley | Rondout Valley CSD is currently working in coordination with the local foodbank on a wider food distribution plan but at the school level we are preparing breakfast/lunch to-go-bags for pickup and are also setting up a delivery system. We hope to have this up and ready by Tuesday, Wednesday at the latest. We have submitted the Child Nutrition application. We are also using the local fire departments as food distribution sites as well as using volunteer school personnel to help deliver food. Our Social Workers are working with the Food Bank to help with coordinating food drop off for families that may not have transportation. |
| Ulster | Saugerties | Saugerties CSD anticipates packing breakfast and lunch and delivering to approximately 10 locations in the district. -breakfast will consist of: shelf stable milk, cereal, fruit. -lunch will consist of: sandwich, fruit, vegetable, milk Home deliveries will be available for some families. |
