#### **NEW BUSINESS**

<u>Draft Resolution 2010-13:</u> Apportionment of Unallocated FFY 2009 and 2010 FTA Section 5307 and 5340 Capital Funds in the Transportation Management Area (TMA): Mr. Doyle stated that the presentation by the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) was related to the Resolution 2010-13. The resolution will transfer the unallocated Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2009 and 2010 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 and 5340 Capital Funds in the Mid-Hudson Valley Transportation Management Area (TMA) to Metro-North to replace/rehabilitate Undergrade bridges in Orange County (West of Hudson). The Technical Committee had the consensus to forward the resolution to the Policy Committee for approval. Mr. Doyle asked for approval of Resolution 2010-13. **Motion to approve by Ms. Rosenblum, seconded by Ms. Budik. All in favor.** 

<u>Draft Resolution 2010-16: Amendment to the FFY 2011-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to modify the Route 9W at Young Avenue Intersection Improvements project, Town of Marlborough (PIN # 823938):</u> Mr. Doyle stated that the Technical Committee has forwarded the resolution for the approval of the Policy Committee. The proposed amendment requires the approval of the Policy Committee. Mr. Doyle asked for approval of Resolution 2010-16. **Motion to approve by Mr. Valk, seconded by Ms. Rosenblum. All in favor.** 

#### OTHER/OLD BUSINESS

Ms. Basnet handed out the copy of financial report. Mr. Samuelson stated that there is a need to revise the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) because of the cost related to printing the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). Mr. Doyle stated that UCTC had originally set aside money for the consultant to do the LRTP. The LRTP was done inhouse, UCTC the incurred copying cost of \$8,000. The money set aside for the consultant to do the LRTP remains unused. Mr. Doyle stated that the amendment to the UPWP will move money from line item for consultant services to line item for supplies. Mr. Doyle asked for the approval of the Policy Committee to amend the UPWP to move \$8,000 from line item for consultant to line item for supplies. Motion to approve by Ms. Rosenblum, seconded by Ms. Budik. All in favor.
