Tick Prevention and Education Program

We provide the community with tick identification, tick removers, and educational resources. The HEU assists with tick surveillance in Ulster County via our tick Identification program. Additionally, in partnership with the Northeast Regional Center for Excellence in Vector-borne Diseases, via tick collection sites in Ulster County for the Tick Blitz in the Hudson Valley Region of New York State. The purpose is to understand where different tick species are present in the State and track their northward expansion.



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
