Proposed Amendments to the State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) has initiated a 15 day public comment period on proposed amendments to the State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

Unified Planning Work Program

The UPWP is UCTC's transportation planning work program that supports the goals, objectives and recommendations of the UCTC's Year 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan. The UPWP includes descriptions of planning tasks and resulting products, and identifies which organization will perform each task, a schedule for completing tasks, the cost of the work, and sources of funds. The Council periodically updates the UPWP to adjust or change a project's cost or scope. Amendments require a public comment period of 15 calendar days prior to action. The proposed amendment to the UPWP is as follows:
