Protecting Water Pipes

To prevent the mess and aggravation of frozen water pipes, protect your home by following these simple steps:

Before cold weather -

- Locate and insulate pipes most likely to freeze typically those near outer walls, in crawl spaces, or in the attic.
- Wrap pipes in UL approved heat tape.
- Seal any holes that allow cold air in where pipes are located.
- Shut off and drain pipes leading to outside faucets.

When its cold -


- Let hot and cold water trickle at night from a faucet on an outside wall.
- Open cabinet doors to let more heat get to un-insulated pipes under a sink near an outside wall.
- Make sure heat is left on and set no lower than 55 degrees.
- If you are going away, 1) have someone check your home daily to make sure the heat is still on, and 2) drain your water system.

If pipes freeze –

- Make sure you and your family know how to shut the water off in case pipes burst. Stopping the water minimizes damage. Call a plumber and your insurance agent.
- Never try to thaw pipes with an open flame or torch
 - Always be careful about potential electric shock around standing water

When the Lights Go Out

If you loose electric power during the winter follow these tips:

- 1. Call your utility to report the outage. Turn off and unplug lights and appliances to prevent a circuit overload when power is restored. Leave one light on to determine when power is back on.
- 2. To help prevent freezing pipes, turn on water faucets slightly.
- 3. Protect yourself from carbon monoxide poisoning:
 - a. DO NOT operate generators indoors.
 - b. DO NOT use charcoal to cook indoors.
 - c. DO NOT use your gas oven to heat your home.
 - d. Make sure fuel space heaters are used with proper ventilation.
- 4. Keep refrigerator and freezer doors closed as much as possible to prevent food spoilage.

Generator Safety

Follow these safety guidelines when operating a generator:

- 1. Before installing a generator, be sure to properly disconnect from your utility electric service. If possible have your generator installed by a qualified electrician.
- 2. Run generators outside, downwind of structures. NEVER run a generator indoors. Deadly carbon monoxide can fill the home. Install a carbon monoxide detector.
- 3. Fuel spilled on a hot generator can cause an explosion. Shut off the generator and let it cool before refilling.
- 4. Do not exceed the rated capacity of your generator. Overloading the generator can damage the generator; the appliances connected to it and may even cause a fire.
- 5. Keep children away from generators at all times.
