**VETERAN SPEAKERS INCLUDE:**

1. **Lauren Bruner**, CA, WWII Navy USS Arizona survivor Pearl Harbor Second to last one to escape burned on 73% of his body, one of only five remaining.
2. **Jack Holder**, AZ, WWII Navy - Flew PBYS, Pearl Harbor Survivor, one of first planes to spot the Japanese at Midway. Credited with sinking a Japanese sub.
3. **Daniel Crowley**, CT, WWII Army Air Corps Fought in the Battles of Bataan and Corregidor, Japanese POW
4. **Hank Kudzik**, PA, WWII Navy Chief Petty Officer on the USS Nautilus 13 war patrols and fought at the battle of Midway.
5. **Charles McGee**, MD, WWII Army Air Corps Tuskegee Fighter Pilot flew 136 combat missions over N Africa, Italy, France & Germany.
6. **Col. Ed Shames**, VA, WWII Army 101st Airborne "Band of Brothers" D-Day landing on through to Hitler's Eagle's Nest.
7. **Henry Flesicher**, FL, WWII Holocaust survivor. Survived the Poland Death March.
8. **Cpl. Ronald Rosser**, OH, Korea Army 38th Infantry Reg. 2nd Infantry Div. Awarded the Medal Of Honor for actions in the vicinity of Ponggilli, Korea 12 January 1952.
9. **John Fer**, MD, Vietnam Airforce Survival Pilot, POW 6 years Hanoi Hilton spent time in cell next to Sen. John McCain.
10. **Jason Redman**, VA, Iraq/Afghanistan, US Navy Seal, 40 combat missions, seriously wounded on last mission. Author of *The Trident*
